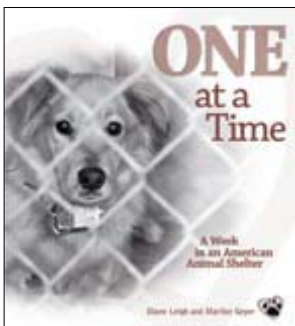


ABOUT THE PUBLISHER

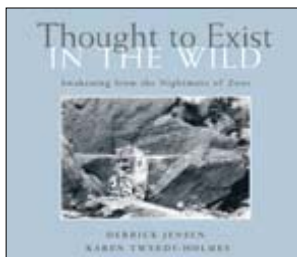
A Week in an American Animal Shelter
